## **Couse Description:**

• This course will offer you opportunities to develop proficiency in modern Japanese at the intermediate level. Our emphasis is on linguistic competency in four components; listening, speaking, reading and writing. There is, however, another important feature of language, which is the knowledge and understanding of the target culture. The instructor will introduce and explain new expressions and grammar patterns, give you the opportunities to practice them, and help you learn Japanese in daily situations within cultural and social contexts. You will gradually gain communicative competency in the Japanese language as a whole.

• This course is designed for those who have completed Japanese 102. If you have taken Japanese at a different university, you must see the instructor immediately regarding placement.

### Course Objectives:

At the end of the semester, you will be able

- to read and write about 110 more *kanji*.
- to talk about yourself and describe things and other people in detail.
- to read and write more complicated sentences.
- to use accurate and contextually appropriate forms of language.
- to write a polite letter.
- to deepen your understanding of Japanese culture, lifestyle, and customs.
